Opening of new surgery for Swanland delayed until May



The Willerby & Swanland Medical Practice has the following message:

'We have been advised that handover from the contractors will be on 25 April and that we should be ready to open to patients on Tuesday 10 May. When we open we will have a bolstered staff team to assist patients orient themselves in the new building - which also means we will need to increase the time between appointments to that will result in a short term reduction in the number of appoints on that day - and possibly for the first few days when we open.

Improvements include a new telephone management system to aim to cut answering times and "on hold" times for our patients, a self check-in solution to reduce reception desk queues, automatic doors and lifts to assist patients with mobility issues or parents with young children, clear and unambiguous signage to direct patients to the right clinical areas. These are just a few of the improvements we are making for our staff and patients.

We have much better car parking facilities in the new location and, **thanks to the efforts of the local councillors at Swanland, there is a direct bus (No 150) to the new surgery from there** in addition to the existing buses.

Those dates are as firm as anyone can make them and we are continuing to work on the logistics to ensure everything happens on time.

Our new address is **Willerby & Swanland Surgery, Willand Primary Care Centre, Lowfield Road, Anlaby HU10 7JR**. Our telephone number will remain the same as now - 01482 652652 - and none of our patients need to change the doctor: all their medical details and records will transfer with us to ensure continuity of care.

We are asking all patients/carers to keep a close eye on our website : www.willerbysurgery.com

This is where the countdown will show our progress and inform patients of the dates and details of the move. We will start to update this on a daily basis from 25 April when we get handover - so any delays can be fully understood by patients. It is also important that patients/carers ensure we have their up-to-date mobile telephone number as we will be using SMS text messaging to confirm move times.'

Parking restrictions in North Ferriby

In response to residents' concerns, parking restrictions in three areas of North Ferriby are due to be consulted upon in the very near future. The three areas are:

- The junction at the bottom of Woodgates Lane and High Street
- The corner of Ings Lane near to the Riding for the Disabled
- The top of Corby Park where it meets Melton Road
